

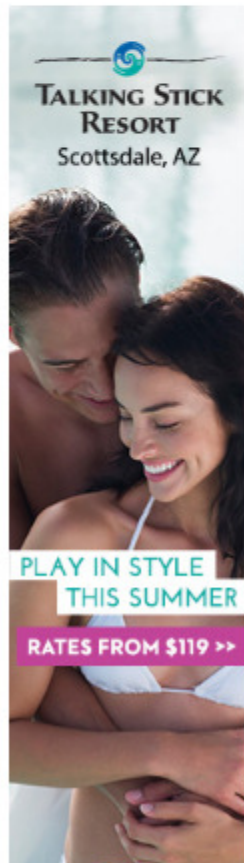


Strip Tips: Cellphone drive, happy hour, open bar
